



SKI MOUNTAINEERING CAMP EQUIPMENT LIST

Skiing/Snowboarding

- Alpine touring ski equipment
 - Rubber-soled AT boots with walk mode required
 - Tech-style bindings *strongly* encouraged
- Or, Splitboard equipment
 - Hard boot set up strongly encouraged
- Climbing skins – must cover full width of ski base
- Goggles
- Repair kit or spare binding parts*

Avalanche Safety

- Avalanche beacon (3 antenna, w/ fresh batteries)
- Avalanche shovel
- Avalanche probe

Required Technical Equipment

- Climbing or ski helmet
- Ice axe – lightweight, 50-60cm
- Boot crampons – aluminum is acceptable
- Ski crampons (required but we cannot provide)
- Lightweight harness (e.g. Petzl Altitude or BD Couloir)

+ We can provide avalanche and required technical equipment—please let us know what you need

Optional Technical Equipment

Not required but useful for learning and practicing

- Lightweight locking and non-locking carabiners
- Cordalette (20' of 6mm cord)
- Sewn dyneema or nylon slings: double length (120 cm)
- Belay device (BD ATC Alpine Guide, Petzl Reverso 4)

***Denotes optional gear**

Misc

- Water bottle(s) 2L
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Map and compass*

Recommended Clothing

- Hardshell, waterproof jacket
- Softshell jacket*
- Hard or softshell pants
- Down or synthetic insulated jacket
- Synthetic/wool long underwear top
- Synthetic/wool long underwear bottom
- Light fleece top
- 2-3 pairs synthetic or wool socks
- Warm, waterproof gloves or mittens
- Lightweight gloves for hiking
- Warm hat
- Brimmed hat or visor
- Neck gaiter or Buff

For Hut/Overnight Use

- Medium-sized pack (40L)
- Sleeping bag liner (we will provide for you to carry)
- Insulated booties or other hut footwear
- Headlamp w/ spare batteries
- Toiletries
- OTC meds you might need (pain relief, cold, etc)
- Comfortable change of clothes for hut
- Swimsuit and small towel for sauna*
- Earplugs*
