### Recommended Climbing Equipment (SMG can provide if necessary):

- [Harness](#) - Adjustable leg loops preferred
- [Helmet](#) (climbing specific)
- Assisted braking device (ABD), such as [Mammut Smart 2.0](#) or Petzl Gri-Gri
- 2-4 locking carabiners
- 2-4 non-locking carabiners
- 30-40L backpack such as [Mammut Trion 38](#)
- 1 double-length (48") sling
- Ice axe (45-55cm, such as Petzl Sum'tec)
- Crampons such as Petzl Sarken (check compatibility with boots)
- Mountain boots—such as Mammut Taiss Light Mid GTX or Kento Pro High GTX
- Rock shoes and chalk bag (route dependent)\*

### Recommended Clothing (Mammut has M's and W's versions of the following products):

- Gore-tex or equivalent shell jacket such as Mammut Taiss HS Hooded (if rain is forecast)
- Synthetic climbing pants such as Mammut Taiss Guide SO or Courmayeur SO
- Sun hoody, such Mammut Selun
- Insulation piece such as Mammut Rime Light
- Light hat or beanie
- Lightweight gloves
- Waterproof gloves
- Neck gaiter or Buff
- Gaitors (depends on conditions, type of pants)\*

### Accessories

- Sunglasses
- Headlamp with spare batteries
- Sunscreen
- Brimmed hat or visor
- Bug repellent\*
- Lip balm\*
- [Restop Bag](#)/Wag Bag\*
- Personal first aid kit (athletic tape, ibuprofen, bandaids, blister material, etc.)\*
- Trekking poles (strongly recommended)\*

### Food and Water

- Lunch
- Snacks
- Minimum 1 liter of water

### Camping Equipment (SMG can provide if necessary)

- Sleeping bag (20-30 degree down or synthetic)
- Sleeping pad
- Stove, fuel, cook pot (can be group gear)
- Cup and spoon
- Tent or bivy sack (can be group gear)
