Skiing/Snowboarding Equipment

- Alpine touring ski equipment
 - Rubber-soled AT boots required
 - Tech-style bindings **strongly** encouraged
- Or, Splitboard equipment
 - Hard boot set up strongly encouraged
- Climbing skins - Must cover full width of ski base
- Poles (collapsible for splitboarders)
- Goggles
- Repair kit and spare binding parts*

Required Technical Equipment

- [Climbing or ski helmet](#)
- Ice axe, lightweight, 50-60 cm
- Boot crampons - Aluminum is acceptable.
- Ski crampons - Required. **WE CANNOT PROVIDE.**

Optional Technical Equipment

Not required but useful for learning and practicing

- Lightweight locking and non-locking carabiners
- Cordalette (20' of 6mm cord)
- Sewn dyneema or nylon slings: double length (120 cm)
- Belay device (BD ATC Alpine Guide, Petzl Reverso 4)

Recommended Clothing

- Hardshell, waterproof jacket, such as Mammut Haldigrat Air HS Jacket
- Softshell jacket, such as Mammut Ultimate VII SO Hooded Jacket*
- Hard or soft shell pants, such as Mammut Taiss Pro SS Pants
- Down or synthetic insulated jacket, such as Mammut Broad Peak IN Hooded Jacket
- 2-3 pairs of synthetic/wool socks
- Synthetic/wool long underwear top
- Synthetic/wool long underwear bottoms
- Light fleece top
- Warm, waterproof gloves or mittens
- Lightweight gloves for hiking
- Warm hat
- Brimmed hat or visor
- Neck gaiter or Buff

Overnight at Hut

- Sleeping bag liner (we will provide)
- Insulated booties or other hut footwear
- Headlamp w/ fresh batteries
- Toiletries
- OTC meds you might need (pain relief, cold, etc)
- Earplugs*

Miscellaneous

- Water bottle 1-2L
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Cell phone/camera (Some coverage around hut)*
- Extra battery pack to charge electronic devices*
